**Nassau County 4-H Requirements for Youth with Market Projects**

As of September 1, 2013 youth ages 8 and older wanting to show a market steer, swine or lamb in the Northeast Florida Fair will be required to earn a minimum of 5 points. These points will be earned by participating in county, district and state level 4-H events & activities. This system has been developed by the Nassau County 4-H Association to help 4-H youth become well-rounded program participants.

County agent signatures are required to verify your participation and this sheet must be presented at the Northeast Florida Fair weigh-in July 2016.
